## Let Your MPP Know

Our health region (WDG Health Unit) has done an excellent job of controlling spread. Before this shutdown, WDG had been classified as orange and seemed to be holding its own at that level of control.

Tennis in an air supported structure has been shown to be safe. Our dome is 1 308 384 cubic feet in size. With 24 players in the dome, that's 54 516 cubic feet of air per person. And, there is a constant exchange of that air due to the need for the structure to stay afloat.

We have operated safely so far through the pandemic. So why are they shutting us down? A letter to your local MPP or the Premier's office might be helpful in getting the government to at least look at air structures differently. We are not gyms!
